This competition showcases the quality of Victoria's prime young stock before a selection will be auctioned by the top ten finalists of the ALPA 2016 Victorian Young Auctioneers Competition.

The cattle must be of a high grade and will be judged in pens of three, prior to being offered by auction to a full gallery of buyers. Places into the competition are limited.

There will be two categories with three classes for entering:

Grain Fed Cattle

A 300kg – 400kg **B** 400kg – 500kg **C** 500kg +

Grass Fed Cattle

A 300kg – 400kg **B** 400kg – 500kg **C** 500kg +
